Photographs of Nantucket go on view tomorrow

Bolstered by the success of his 2003 black and white “São Miguel Series” of the Azores, photographer/painter Henry Krauzyk follows with the debut of his “Coastal New England Series.”

The first segment of the series, titled “Nantucket,” will be on exhibition from tomorrow to April 12 at the Cherry & Webb Gallery in Fall River.

“I live in coastal New England and after the success of the São Miguel series, it seemed the next logical step,” says Mr. Krauzyk.

The first body of work in the series focuses on Nantucket, though Mr. Krauzyk confides that the series is long-term. “I want to capture a comprehensive record of our region from Southern Connecticut to the Maine/Canada border,” he says.

He is currently at work on the SouthCoast and in Rhode Island with plans to visit Cape Cod and Martha’s Vineyard in the coming spring and summer.

“I’ve already captured some great color as well as black and white images in Rhode Island and I’m

expecting similar success in the new areas,” says Mr. Krauzyk. “I’m also not going to say I’m finished with Nantucket yet.”

“We live in a very beautiful part of the country,” he said.

The exhibition, also featuring the work of fellow photographer Thomas Willusz, will display more than 20 works from Krauzyk’s “Coastal New England Series.”

The exhibit will open tomorrow evening at 139 S. Main St., Fall River. Mr. Krauzyk will be there to answer questions and offer insight into this exciting new chapter of his career.
